Four Categories in Competition Group

(The top three of each group will be selected)

- 1. Youth Artist Award (Amateur and Professional group under 30) , Adult Music Award (For professional over 31) Solo and ensemble**

- 2 .Special Theme Award: (Pianos, Strings, Brasses) , Youth Artist Award Amateur and Professional group under 30 , Adult Music Award (Amateur and professional) . Solo and ensemble**
 - a. J.S Bach Award**
 - b. F.F Chopin Award) (Piano only)**

3. Chinese Music Award (Excluding traditional Chinese instrumental music),(Amateur and Professional group under 30 , Amateur and professional over 31) Solo and ensemble

4. Outstanding Performance Award (Competition group)

All instrumental and vocal,Amateur group under 30 and Amateur Adult Music Award For over 31(Solo and Ensemble)

Outstanding Performance Award(Performance group)

(Selected acting awards, outstanding performance awards, no ranking)

All instrumental and vocal , Amateur group under 30 and over 31 (Solo and ensemble)

Competition Group Application Fees (Online and Offline):

1.Solo: \$60 CAD,

2.Ensemble for 2 performers) : \$120 CAD ,

3.Ensemble for 3 or more performers : \$40 CAD Per person

Outstanding Performance Award (Performance Group) Application Fees:

1.Solo: \$25 CAD

2.Ensemble for 2 performers : \$50 CAD,

3.Ensemble for 3 or more performers : \$18 CAD Per person

Note :

 * One person can register for one music category and one age group. Add additional items, fill out the form again and pay

 * When registering a band, the age should be determined by the oldest member of the band

 * Solo works must be memorized (only four-hand piano, Western string sonatas, ensemble and chorus can look at the score)

Applicable Awards and Requirements

1. Youth Artist Award, Adult Music Award (Amateur and Professional group under 30 and over 31)

a. Solo contestants must select TWO contrasting pieces. One piece must be from the Classical period. The other piece can be any period of choice.

Limited to: piano solo, violin solo, viola solo, cello solo, Double Bass solo

b. ONE piece of choice

Chinese instrument , Vocal, Brasses, Percussion, guitar, wind, Harp, Four Hands Piano, and all ensembles, duets and choruses

2. Special Theme Award (Amateur and Professional group under 30 and over 31 : Piano, Strings, Windpipes, Brasses Solo and Ensemble)

a. J.S Bach Award:

ONE Work of J.S Bach

b. Chopin Award :

ONE Work of Chopin (Piano Only)

3. Chinese Music Award (Amateur and Professional group under 30 and over 31 : Solo and Ensemble, excluding Chinese instruments)

ONE Chinese works

4. Outstanding Performance Award (Competition Group
Amateur Group under 30 and over 31 : Solo And
Ensemble)

ONE piece from Baroque, Classical, Romantic, and Contemporary Periods

 Young Artist Award and Adult Music Award: Piano and Strings Solo Amateur Category and Professional Category need to prepare two pieces ,and all other categories need to prepare one piece only.

- Special Contribution Award (a teacher whose student has won the first prize five times in a row)
